

# TERRITORIAL INNOVATION

The recent global pandemic, climate change, and the economic and financial crisis, pose numerous challenges to today's cities and regions. Local administrators, sociologists, economists, architects, spatial planners and many other professionals have to deal with a number of issues related to urbanisation. This requires innovative designs, with an eye to resilience and sustainability, for future habitats (Schröder, 2020), new forms of governance (Van den Hurk & Tasan-Kok, 2020), innovative models of entrepreneurship (Mangialardo & Micelli, 2018), neglected sites management (Scaffidi, 2019), digitalisation, and creative processes of urban design and planning (Carta, 2020; Contato, 2019).

The Symposium aims to discuss the state-of-the-art, policies, projects on territorial innovation, and to provide new insights into this field. We want to discuss cutting-edge approaches towards sustainable, and resilient cities, regions and communities.

The Symposium discusses important topics related to urban resilience and sustainability, circular economy, participatory governance, and cultural, digital and social innovation. It will explore socio-economic, and spatial issues for innovative cities and regions. During these times of uncertainty, social isolation, environmental and health crises, there is a need for academics to debate these topics and provide practical recommendations and innovative and sustainable solutions for different contexts.

## SESSION 1: Governance, Planning, Urban and Territorial Design

The first session focuses on projects, policies on urban resilient, governace, and innovation in urban and territorial design.

## SESSION 2: Entrepreneurship and Circular Economy

The second session aims to discuss about new business and management models, and good practices of circular economy.

### SESSION 3: Stakeholder Engagement and Social Innovation

The third session focuses on resilient communities, stakeholder engament, social innovation and cases of participatory governance.
